TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALES REPRESENTATIVE LICENSING EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Registration for Course is **SEPARATE** from Registration for Examination.
- Examination fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- ALL Applicants MUST complete an Examination Registration Form and submit with the relevant examination fee. Application forms without the requisite fees will not be accepted.
- ALL application forms MUST include Manager's Name, Signature, date of examination and contact number. The Company stamp MUST also be affixed.
- Complete Application Form(s) MUST be accompanied by a cover letter signed by the Manager indicating the name(s) of candidate(s) and the particular examinations. Application forms submitted without the corresponding letter will NOT be accepted.

A CANDIDATE IS REGISTERED WHEN THE COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM, REQUISITE PAYMENT AND COVER LETTER ARE SUBMITTED BEFORE OR ON THE DUE DATE.

- Applicants MUST submit a VALID FORM OF IDENTIFICATION on the date of the
 examination in order to be allowed to write the examination. Failure to present a
 valid form of identification will result in the candidate not being allowed to sit the
 particular examination.
- Applicants should be informed that ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST
 BE TURNED OFF BEFORE ENTERING THE EXAMINATION ROOM. Failure to
 comply will result in an automatic ejection from the particular examination.
- 8. A Candidate who has substantial medical reason for missing an examination should submit this in writing within two (2) working days from the date of the missed examination.
- Deferral from an examination MUST be submitted in writing within five (5) working days BEFORE the commencements of the exams. The deferral will be for the next exam sitting ONLY.
