TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The College of Insurance & Professional Studies reserves the right to vary or cancel a course where there is a lack of numbers to start the course. Where a course is cancelled, applicants will be refunded in full.
- 2. An individual may discontinue classes, provided written notice is submitted, received and permission obtained. Company sponsored individuals should consult with their Training/HR Managers prior to withdrawing from a course. Candidates who discontinue a course after the first two classes are required to pay fifty percent (50%) of fees which will become payable immediately. Attendance to three or more classes and withdrawal from that class will require a 100% payment of course fees.

Should an individual need to discontinue a course after the first two classes, due to extenuating circumstances, full fees MUST be paid within the course period and the individual will be allowed to participate in the next available course.

This concession will be granted based on the College's discretion.

The College will not write off fees owed by students who withdraw from courses without the College's permission. Company-sponsored and self-sponsored students will be liable for outstanding fees.
